Despite initial concerns regarding Melissa's future after surviving the attempt to end her life at approximately seven months gestation, she has not only survived, but thrived.

Melissa has been featured on television and radio programs including: Fox News, Focus on the Family, American Family Radio and more. She has testified before the U.S. House of Representatives, the U.S. Senate and the Australian Parliament.

In 2012, Melissa founded The Abortion Survivors' Network (ASN). ASN seeks to educate the public about failed abortions and survivors while providing emotional, mental and spiritual support to abortion survivors.
